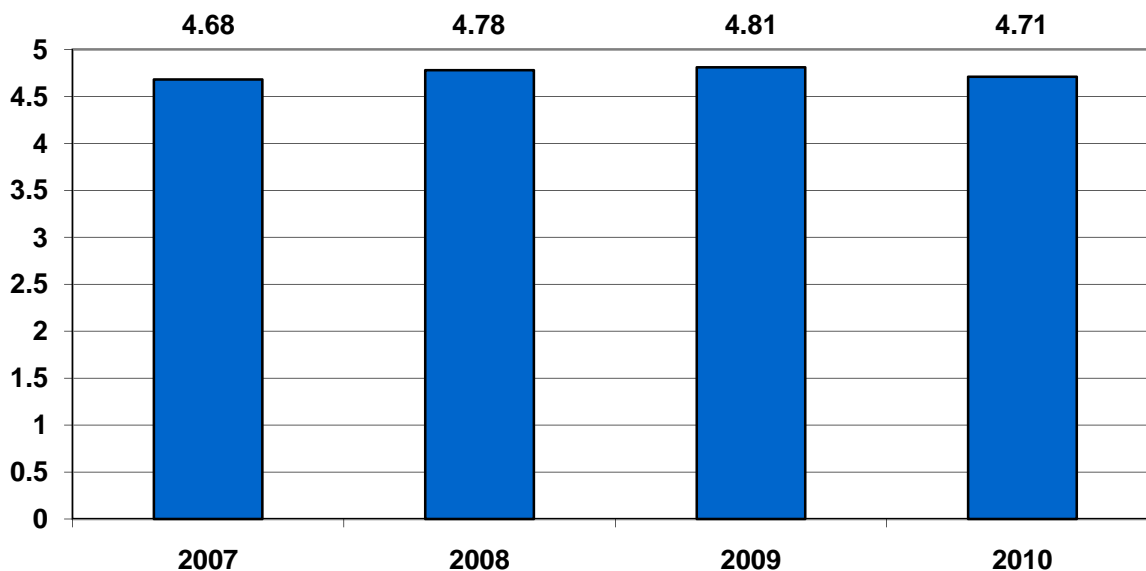




Strategic Risk Solutions Maintains High Customer Satisfaction Ratings
